Essential : A. Educational : (i) A medical qualification included in the I or II schedule or Part II of the Third Schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act of 1956. (Persons possessing qualifications included in Part II of third schedule should also fulfill the conditions specified in sub-section (3) of section 13 of the Act). The candidate must be registered with the State/Central Medical Council. (ii)M.D. (Preventive Social Medicine/Community Medicine) with three years professional experience after M.D.

Experience: 3 years teaching and/or research experience in a recognized Institution in the subject of specialty after obtaining the qualifying degree of M.D.

Preference will be given to those who have research experience in TB and Respiratory Diseases

Age :- Upto 45 years. (Relaxable for Government Servants upto five years in accordance with the instructions or orders issued by the Central Government.)

Essential Qualification :

i) A recognized medical qualification included in the I or II Schedule or

Part-II of the third schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act of 1956. (Persons possessing qualifications included in Part-II of third schedule should also fulfill the conditions specified in sub-section of Section 13 of the Act).

- ii) A post-graduate qualification, e.g. M.D., in Microbiology from an Indian University or qualification recognized equivalent thereto.

Experience :

3 years experience in a recognized Institution after obtaining the qualifying post graduate degree.

Note I : The Medical qualifications possessed by the candidates should have the recognition of the Medical Council of India.

Note II : Holders of speciality Board of USA qualifications should complete the entire requirements of the Board concerned.

Note III: In so far as post graduate medical qualifications awarded by Indian Universities are concerned, they should also find a place in the Schedules to the Indian Medical Council Act 1956, as amended from time to time.

Age : Upto 45 years. Relaxable for Government servants upto 5 years in accordance with the instructions or orders issued by Central Government.

Essential Qualification : (a)A recognized medical Qualification included in the I or II schedule or Part II of the third schedule (other than the Licentiate Qualifications) to the Indian Medical Council Act of 1956. Holders of educational qualifications included in Part II of third schedule should also fulfill the conditions specified in sub-section (3) of section 13 of IMC the Act) - 1956

(b) Double Post Graduate i.e. MD/MS along with M.Ch. (Thoracic Surgery)/M.Ch. (Cardio Thoracic Surgery) or Speciality board of Thoracic Surgery (USA) OR equivalent.

(C) In case a M.Ch. (CTS) candidate is not available, M.S.(Surgery) with experience in Thoracic Surgery will also be considered.

Experience: Two years working experience after obtaining the first Postgraduate Degree of MS/MD

Note-I: The Medical Qualifications possessed by the candidates should have the recognition of the Medical Council of India.

Note-II: Holders of speciality board of USA qualifications should complete the entire requirements of the Board concerned.

Note-III: In so far as post graduate medical qualifications awarded by Indian Universities are concerned, they should also find a place in the Schedules to the Indian Medical council Act, 1956, as amended from time to time.

Note-IV: In the case of holder of DM. /M.Ch. qualification of five years duration, the period of senior post graduate residency rendered in the last part of the said D.M/M.Ch.

shall be counted towards requirement of five years experience.

Note-V: In the case of qualification in Super-Specialities (M.Ch. /D.M) except in the case of holders of D.M/M.Ch. of five years duration, the holders should have obtained M.D. (General Medicine) or M.S. (General Surgery) or an equivalent qualification as prescribed by the said council in its recommendations on post graduate medical examination.

Age: Upto 45 years (relaxable for Government servants upto 5 years in accordance with the instructions or orders issued by Central Government)

General Instructions:

1. Crucial date for determining age limit will be the closing date of receipt of applications.
2. Relaxation in age limit shall be considered as per the government of India rules in this regard.
3. The appointment will be governed by the standard terms and conditions as per the Institute rules applicable from time to time.
4. NITRD reserves the right to fix criteria for calling the required number of candidates, as may be necessary, for written test/interview.
5. The prescribed essential qualifications as above are bare minimum and the mere possession of the same does not entitle a candidate to be called for written test/interview.
6. NITRD reserves the right to fill or not to fill the posts mentioned above without assigning any reason(s).
7. No. of posts can be increased or decreased by the Competent Authority.
8. Incomplete applications or those not on the prescribed proforma shall be summarily rejected.
9. The candidate already in Govt. Service should send his/her application through proper channel, or submit 'No Objection Certificate' from their present employer with their application.
10. Candidates are required to enclose self-attested Photostat copies of all certificates in support of their qualifications and experience.
11. Applicants should affix recently taken self-attested passport size photograph on the application.
